<u>GENESIS/EMERGENCY CARDS:</u> Please take a minute to check that all information in Genesis is correct (i.e. names, address, email address and phone numbers) and matches the information on the emergency card. This information is used to generate all correspondence (school messages) and is needed to make sure you are receiving electronic information and securing release of your child to the proper parent/guardian.
